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Quick Start Guide

Step 1 Plug into a 110v outlet

Step 2 Adjust sealing time according to the thickness of the bag.



NOTE: 2-4 seconds is an adequate time for most bags. The thicker the bag, the longer the seal time.

Step 3 Place your bag across the sealing area.

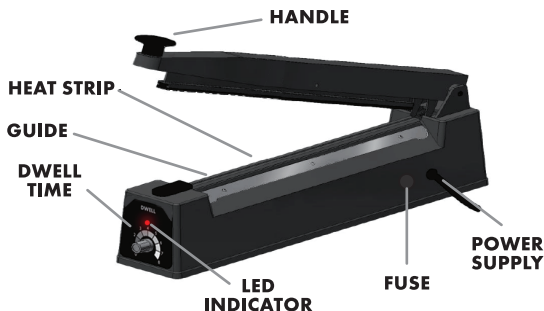


NOTE: No warm up time is required & heating is only applied while the light is on.

Step 4 Push down firmly on the handle to close the mouth of the impulse sealer. When the signal light goes off, please continue to press down for an additional 3 seconds for optimal results.

Step 5 Inspect seal to confirm times are correct. If times are not correct, please adjust accordingly before sealing your next bag.

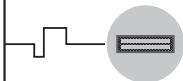

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**WARNING!**

To reduce the risk of shock, disconnect the unit from the supply circuit before servicing the replacement of the heat strip!



1. *Before use, check the device to see if it is damaged or if there are any defective accessories.*
2. *Keep the sealer's surface clean to avoid oxidation and promote longer lifespan on your heat strip.*
3. *For proper function of the sealer, regularly check the rubber of the press part for better sealing after continuous use.*
4. *During operation, keep the device at a safe distance from your face and eyes.*
5. *Never wipe the heat strip with a wet cloth.*
6. *Never immerse the body of the unit in water.*
7. *Do not allow children to use the sealer as a toy; special care should be taken when children or persons with disabilities are near the unit.*
8. *Do not misuse the cord. Never use the cord for carrying, pulling, or unplugging the unit. Keep the cord away from heat, oil, sharp edges, or moving parts. Damaged or entangled cords increase risk of electrical shock.*
9. *In case of electrical or mechanical malfunction, immediately switch off the unit and unplug it.*

SEAL WIRE REPLACEMENT

1. Unplug the unit
2. Loosen screws for the Teflon tape hold-down strips.
3. Remove the Teflon tape; replacement may be necessary if damaged.
4. The heat strip is held in place by two Philips screws, one on each end of the wire. First, remove the screw on the end closest to the dwell timer. NOTE: Depending on the model, you may have a black plastic cover that must be removed before completing this step.
5. Next, remove the screw on the opposing end to release the seal wire.
6. When installing the wire, start with the screw nearest the hinge. NOTE: Take caution not to over tighten the screw.
7. Pull the wire across and install the opposing screw. Once again, take caution not to over tighten.
8. Replace or reinstall the Teflon tape, if replacing, trimming of the tape may be necessary.
9. Before tightening down on the tape hold down screws, make sure to center the tape, and flatten it out to prevent creases.
10. Plug the unit back in and test.

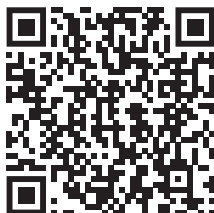
