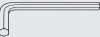
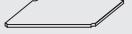




SS Steel Cart

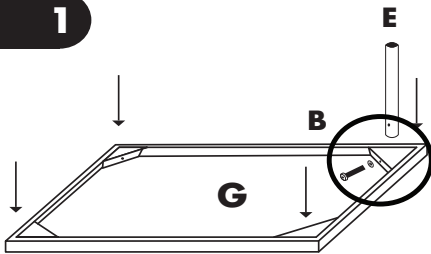
INSTRUCTIONS (PART# 100-90)

PARTS NEEDED

A		A	(4) SHORT SCREWS
B		B	(4) LONG SCREWS
C		C	ALLEN KEY
D		D	4 CASTERS
E		E	CART LEGS (1 HOLE)
F		F	CART LEGS (3 HOLES)
G		G	UPPER SHELF
H		H	LOWER SHELF

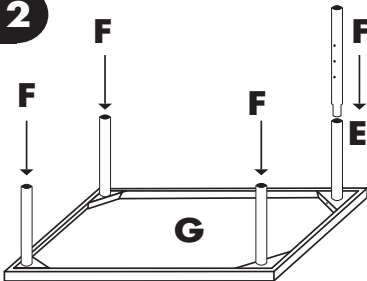
REMOVE WHITE PROTECTIVE FILM. **CAUTION:** EDGES OF STAINLESS STEEL MAY BE SHARP. **TAKE CAUTION WHEN HANDLING.**

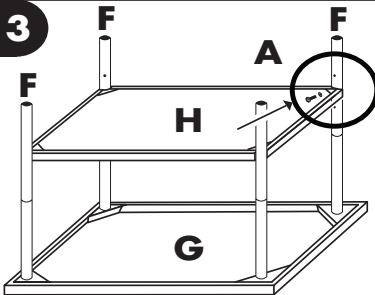
STEP ONE: Grab the **UPPER SHELF (G)** and flip it upside down. Install one half of the **cart legs (E)** that have one hole. Fasten legs to **UPPER SHELF** using the provided **allen key (C)** and the **long screws (B)**. *NOTE: Finger tighten screws.*

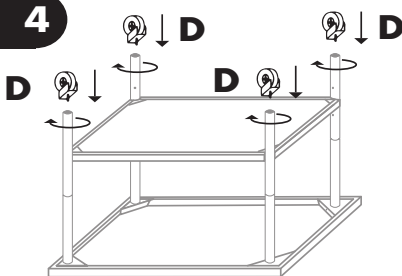
STEP TWO: Install the second half of the **cart legs (F)** into the first half. *NOTE: All screw holes should face inward.*

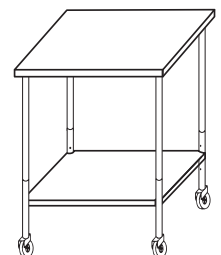


STEP THREE: Once the **cart legs (F)** are fully installed, fasten the **LOWER SHELF (H)** to the second half of the **cart legs (F)** using the **short screws (A)** into the desired hole for height. *NOTE: Do not overtighten shelf screws. After step 3, return & snug down long screws (B) in step 1.*

STEP FOUR: Finally, grab the **casters (D)** and screw them into the **cart legs (F)**. *NOTE: Keep casters with brakes on the same short edge of the cart.*
